For the last two years, I have been working with a group of Mulkey Cemetery plot owners to orient them to cemetery issues as they become the expanded board of directors. Their names are listed below.

The new board and I have outlined general goals for the future and will be meeting with neighbors and interested plot owners to inform them, and we will listen to all ideas.

One of the consequences of my retirement, along with rising costs of maintenance, is that there is now a gap of about \$5,000 in needed income just to maintain the cemetery in its current condition.

Because of this shortfall, we are raising our basic dues from \$25 to \$30 this year, and we hope that everyone will consider an additional gift.

In the meantime, the cemetery is looking beautiful this spring; come visit and enjoy the flowers, the open space, and the knowledge that there is an orderly transition of management occurring.

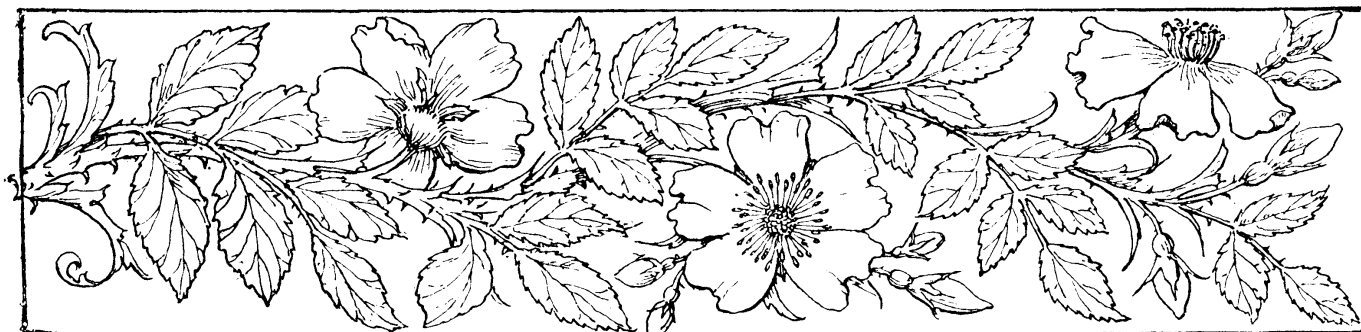
